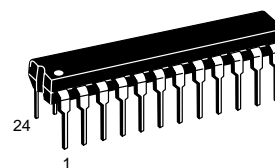

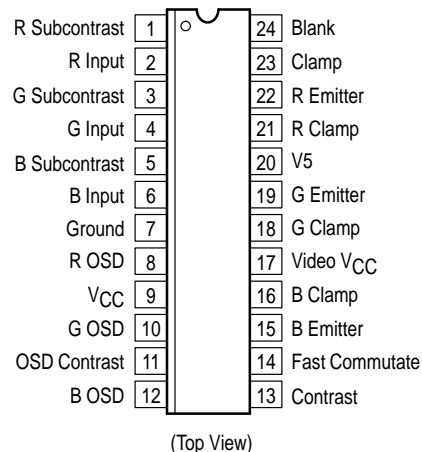

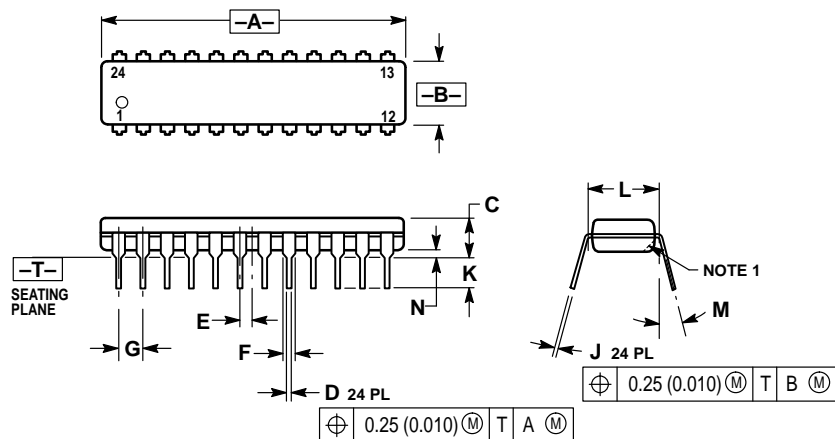
PIN CONNECTIONS
